Kiangsu-Chekiang College was founded by Kiangsu Chekiang and Shanghai Residents (HK) Association in 1958 and became a Direct Subsidy School in 1993.

Our School :

- offers holistic education and has developed a tradition of excellence in teaching and learning;
- emphasizes bilingual education (English and Chinese). We offer both English class and Chinese class in each secondary level. Chinese Language and Chinese History in junior forms are taught in Putonghua;
- provides WiFi network in the whole school to enhance e-learning;
- offers 38 extra-curricular activities to challenge students intellectually, physically and artistically;
- provides a wide range of special and functional rooms: Audio-Visual Language Centre, Multi-media Learning Centre, Computer Rooms and KCC Campus TV Station to enhance teaching and learning practices;
- offers computing facilities in the Library where 40,000 books and publications are stored. Our Library can accommodate more than 200 students;
- offers 400 seats in the School Canteen (junior form students ought to stay in school for lunch);
- offers air-conditioned classrooms and special rooms;

- offers International Baccalaureate course in our International Section. Interested students in F.4 could apply for the one-year Preparatory Course and start the two-year course in Year 12;

## Notes to applicants :

### A. F.1 Discretionary Places ( Number of discretionary places is 30 )

1. P.6 students can submit the application through our school website for Form 1 Discretionary Places.
2. Completed forms with copies of transcripts in P.5 and P.6 (First Term) should be submitted to the School from 4th to 18th January, 2021. ( Recommendation letter from Primary school is not needed )
3. Interview will be held on 6th March, 2021 ( Saturday ), all applicants would be informed by mail.
4. Criteria of admission are as follows:  
Rank Order List from EDB (25%), Conduct and Teachers' Comments (25%),  
Academic Results in P.5 and P.6(1st term) (20%), Interviews (10%),  
Extra-curricular activities (10%), Awards (5%) and School and Social Service (5%).
5. The School will notify parents of all successful applicants of their children's inclusion in the Successful Lists for Discretionary Places by letter and phone on 31st March 2021. School will inform parents of the notification arrangements, and collect necessary contact information from parents beforehand. These notification arrangements are not applicable to reserve and unsuccessful applicants, **nor are the notifications the formal allocation results.**

### B. F.1 Non-Discretionary Places

1. P.6 students can apply through our website for Form 1 (2021-2022) School Places. Interview will be held on 6th March, 2021 ( Saturday ), applicants will submit the copies of transcripts in P.5 and P.6 (First Term).
2. Criteria for admissions are as follows:  
Academic Results in P.5 and P.6 (1st term) (30%), Conduct and Teachers' Comments (30%), Interviews (20%),  
Extra-curricular activities (10%), School and Social Service (5%) and Awards (5%).
3. Newly arrived students can also apply for places in our School, admitted students will have fund for their English tutorials.
